Greetings Juneau School District Staff:

The Alaska Society for Technology in Education (ASTE) has posted the rules for the 2010 iDidaContest with the first place prize for each category being \$100. The prize is open to all students, staff, educators associated with a school district in the State of Alaska.

What can you enter? There are four categories:

iDidaTunes: an original arrangement or song with the theme *Entertain Us* (like something you would make in GarageBand)

iDidaPodcast: an original podcast with three theme categories – *Make Me Laugh, Tells a Story, Public Service Announcement*

iDidaPhoto: an original photo, also with three theme categories – *Make Me Laugh, Tells a Story, Alaska Life*

iDidaMovie: an original movie with three themes – *Make Me Laugh, Tell Me a Story, Teach Me Something*
