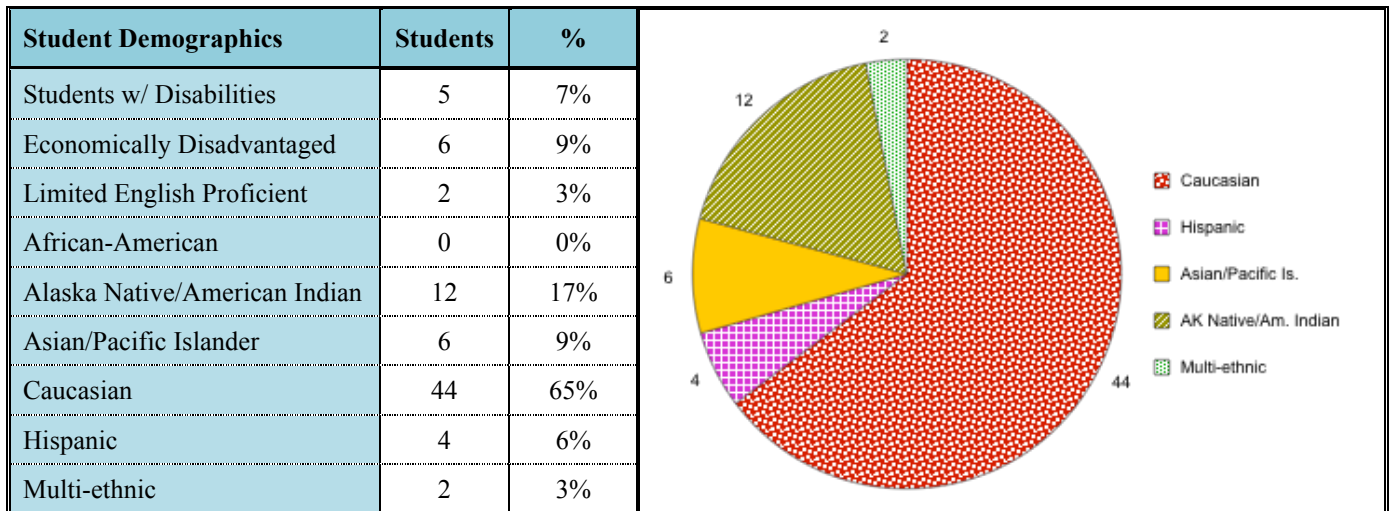
HomeBRIDGE Program
